





Through the Super Kids Club and Super Teens Club, New Horizons has demonstrated success in improving the graduation rate among underresourced youth in SWFL. These programs provide after school tutoring and mentoring along with daily lessons and encouragement needed to succeed in school and life.



Programs

Super Kids Club

K-5th grade after-school programming takes place on Monday through Thursday during the school year.

Super Teens Club

6th-12th grade after-school programming takes place on Monday through Thursday during the school year.

Super Kids & Teens Clubs

The Friday afternoon club prepares 4th & 5th grade boys and girls for middle school.

After school on Friday, 11th & 12th graders receive personalized help applying and preparing for college and vo-tech programs.
