

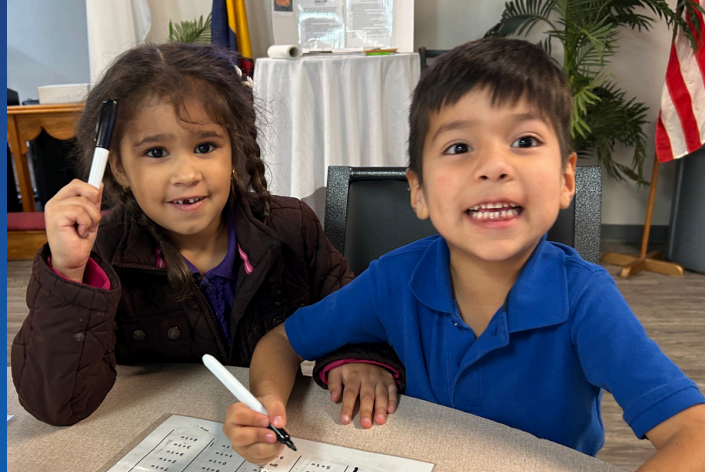
Spotlight on: Terri Pilla

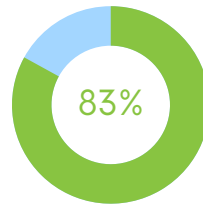
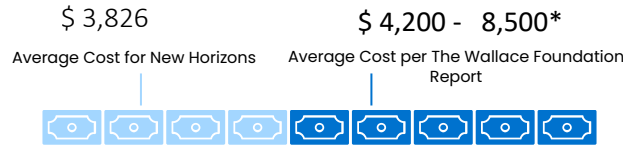
86% of STC students had a GPA of 2.0 or higher

78% OF SKC STUDENTS MAINTAINED A "C" OR HIGHER IN READING



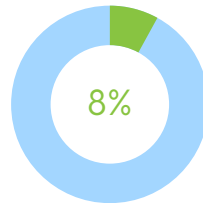
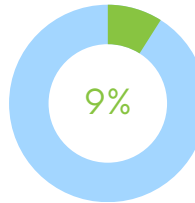
